

Key Point 01

INFO Tab populates all other tabs

Key Point 02

Hover over each red triangle for more info

Key Point 03

FEDBAL due 11/15 only if unspent FEDERAL

Key Point 04

SYSOPS: Report FEDERAL Part C only

Key Point 05

PROVIDER is sum of all secondary (THERAPY)

Key Point 06

Allocate anticipated revenues only

Identify Anticipated Revenues

Deficit ≠ Anticipated Revenue

Allocate Anticipated Revenues

Identify deficits by line item

Identify total deficit in cell B75

payor of ast resort made easy:

Federal Part C of IDEA dollars are the last to be used when purchasing Part C early intervention services.



may a local system...

Spend federal Part C funds within systems operations at any time?

Spend federal Part C funds for salaries of direct service providers employed by the LLA at any time?

Allocate federal Part C funds to purchase early intervention services (from contracted providers or agencies)?

Spend allocated federal Part C funds to purchase early intervention services at any time?

Those allocated federal Part C funds must be spent after all other dollars have

The local system must be able to articulate and demonstrate the procedures followed to ensure compliance with Part C payor of last resort requirements.
