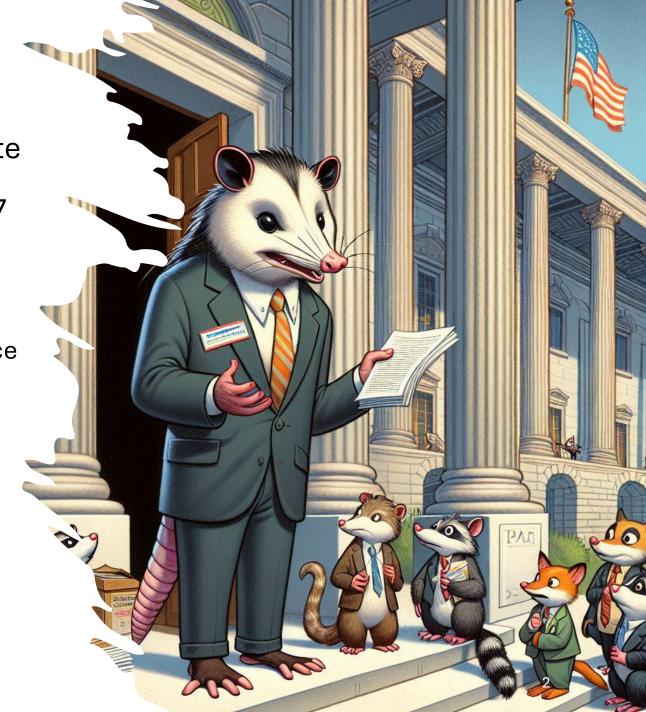

Purpose of CIMV

- CIMV: Process used by SLA to evaluate local and statewide performance on Part C compliance indicators (C1, C7 and C8)
- Statewide data reported in annual SPP/APR
 - States report performance on compliance indicators as well as results indicators
 - Required by OSEP (February)
 - Used by OSEP for annual state determinations
- Local results published online following SPP/APR submission (February)



CIMV Timeline

- States determine when and how to evaluate Part C compliance
 - Virginia reviews entirety of three (3) months of data
 - January, February, and March
- Raw data from 40 LEIS become basis for statewide performance calculations
 - Compliance indicator targets are always100%
- Best way to prepare for CIMV is to regularly self-monitor and identify errors or missing data



Federal TRAC-IT Reports

- For CIMV (as well as) ongoing monitoring use federal reports in TRAC-IT
 - C1 30-day Timeline
 - C7 45-day Timeline
 - C8A-B-C Transition
- You can run these at any time!
- For CIMV, staff pulls official (SPP/APR reportable) local results on May 15th (or following business day if a weekend or holiday)



C1: Timely Initiation of Services

- Denominator = # IFSPs signed within review period containing 1+ new services during period
 - Includes initial and IFSP reviews
- Numerator = # of IFSPs for which all services began w/in 30-day timeline (or compliant reasons for delays)
- Example:
 - 100 IFSPs signed January 1 March
 31.
 - For 98 IFSPs, all services timely or compliant; 2 IFSPs noncompliant
 - 98/100 = 98%



TRAC-IT Needs to Know: What Happened?

- Service note will specify service date
 - TRAC-IT evaluates to determine timeliness
- If NO service note entered (i.e., no service date captured), outcome is UNKNOWN
- Key points:
 - Services remain unknown until note entered or ad hoc task completed
 - If C1 report includes UNKNOWN(s), no compliance % can be calculated
 - LEIS must ensure that all unknowns are resolved prior to state review

Sample C1 Report w/ 38 Unknowns

Identify and Resolve Unknowns

- Two ways to identify unknowns:
 - o C1 report
 - o Dashboard tile
- Service delivered?
 - YES: Ensure note is entered (and reason for delay, if any, is provided)
 - NO: Use "reason for late" ad hoc task to account for the delay
- Rerun the C1 report as needed to ensure all unknowns have been cleared
- REMINDER: There <u>must</u> be a local compliance percentage on the C1 report when run by ITCVA staff on May 15th

C7: 45-Day Timeline

- Denominator = all initial IFSP meeting dates entered into TRAC-IT w/in the review period
- Numerator = all initial IFSP meeting dates entered into TRAC-IT w/in the review period that occurred w/in 45 days of referral (or late for compliant reasons)

• Example:

- Initial IFSP meeting dates for 100 children were entered in TRAC-IT
- 80 dates evaluated as w/in 45 days; 10 evaluated as late for compliant reasons; 10 evaluated as late for noncompliant reasons
- (80+10)/100 = 90.0% compliance percentage

C8: Transition / C8A

- One TRAC-IT report for all three C8 indicators (A-B-C)
 - Each w/ its own aggregate and detail tabs
- C8A denominator: All children exiting at age 3* with one of four possible transition destinations:
 - o Part B eligible
 - Part B referral; eligibility NYD
 - Not Part B eligible; exit w/ referrals
 - Not Part B eligible; exit w/o referrals
- C8A numerator: All children w/ complete and timely transition plans

Sample C8 Report: Transition Plan Aggregate Tab (C8a)

C8: Transition; C8B

- C8B and C8C include only those children (from C8A denominator) deemed potentially eligible for Part B (as indicated w/ checkmark in TRAC-IT)
- C8B denominator: All children w/ permission to notify LEA/SEA
- C8B numerator: All children for whom notification is sent (timely or compliant delay) to both LEA/SEA

Sample C8 Report: Referral Aggregate Tab (C8b)

C8: Transition; C8C

- C8C seeks to evaluate the following: for families that gave permission, did transition planning conferences occur and did they occur within timeline?
- Again, this report includes all children deemed potentially eligible for Part B (as indicated w/ checkmark in TRAC-IT)
- C8C denominator: All children w/ permission for TPC
- C8C numerator: All children for whom TPC held and w/in timelines
