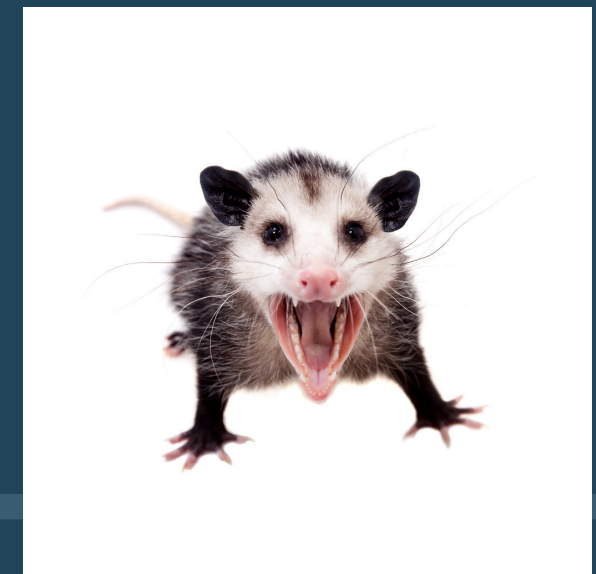
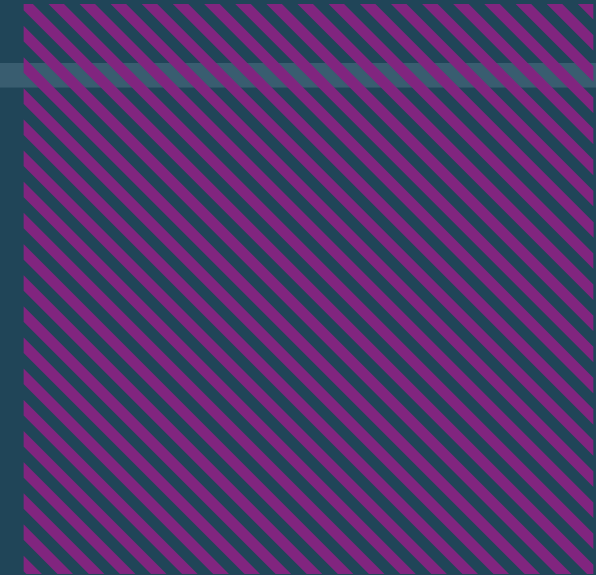

SSLM begins annually on July 1st



- ✓ **On the 13th of each month** run and review the appropriate TRAC-IT federal report and note the calculated percentage.

If no percentage is noted (C-01)
“clear the unknowns”

- ✓ Add comments beside each delay to explain the reason for the delay.
- ✓ Save and securely transmit a copy to your Part C MC by the **20th of the month.**

Correction Logic

C-01 Timely Initiation of Services

- ✓ Review 2 months prior
(e.g., In June check April)

100% Compliance



C-07 45 Day Timeline and C-08 Transition

- ✓ Review 1 month prior
(e.g., In June check May)

<100% Compliance



Structured Monitoring: Not Just a Task — A Tool

It's a tool for:

- Tracking, Reviewing, Acting, and Correcting in Time
- Addressing noncompliance before it becomes a systemic issue
- Collaborating with TACs & MCs
- Ensuring every child gets timely support
