## **POSM Evolution: Tweaks**



- Timelines
  - 2 Quarters Backward (e.g., POSM in 3<sup>rd</sup> Q, Cases from 1<sup>st</sup> Q)
  - 16 Weeks Start to Finish
- In: Survey Data | Out: Family and Provider Interviews
- Additional Clarification Added to Protocols (August 2025)





# POSM Evolution: 16-Week Timeline

#### Weeks 1-4

- Case Selection
- POSM Planning Call
- LLA Documentation → SLA
- LLA Survey Distribution → Field

#### Weeks 9 – 12

- LSM Interview
- LLA Case Documentation → SLA
- Initial Report Draft

### Weeks 5 – 8

- Case Reviews
- Documents Review
- Survey Results Compilation
- LSM Interview Prep

### Weeks 13 - 16

- Internal Report Review and Approval
- SLA POSM Report → LLA
- Closeout Call; Next Steps

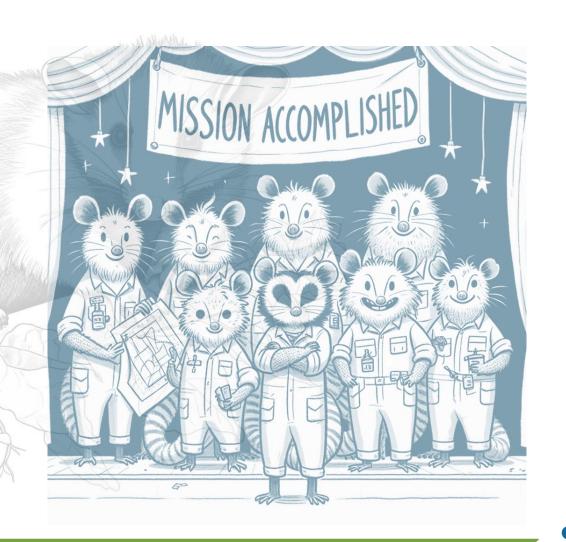
